**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC MEETING: PROPOSED FY22 APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE**

Mayor Coladipietro noted that notice was published in the local edition of the DuPage County Chronicle for one day on May 25, 2022 for this public hearing.

Finance Director Gary Szott explained the purpose of the meeting. Annually this ordinance is made to define the annual legal spending limits of the Village budget. This ordinance is for the FY22/23 fiscal year and must be completed during the first quarter of the fiscal year. The total amount in the ordinance is higher than the amounts shown on the budget to provide flexibility on spending due to unforeseen circumstances. The ordinance was on the Village website and available for review at the Village Hall.

Mayor Coladipietro then opened the floor to the Village Board for comments.

The only comment came from Mayor Coladipietro who noted that the ordinance reflects the budget but any time that any spending is over budget it comes before the Village Board for approval.


There was no comment from the public.
