

COVID-19 Related School & Public Facility Closures

Elementary Schools:

Bloomington School District 13: Closed until Monday, April 6.

Marquart School District 15: Remote E-learning began on Wednesday, March 18, anticipated reopening on April 6.

Community Consolidated School District 93: Closed until Monday, April 6, although the closure may extend beyond April 6. The district's goal is to begin providing remote learning opportunities on Tuesday, March 17. March 30 through April 3 will be spring break with no assignments for students. The district expects to have meals available through March 27 for students who need food during the closure.

High Schools:

Lake Park High School District 108: All school buildings closed to students through April 5. All activities and events at the campuses are cancelled through spring break. Students will be "in school" virtually as the District provides continuity of instruction from March 17-19 and March 24-25.

Glenbard District 87: Remote E-Learning for students will start on Monday March 16 for all Glenbard schools until further notice. March 30 – April 4 is Spring Break. Food for students in need will start Tuesday, March 17.

Village of Bloomington Facilities:

Effective March, 2020, all Village Facilities (including the Police Department) are closed for public visitation. All Village Departments continue to be operational at this time, and services are available remotely to the public as summarized in the separate Facility Closure notice, that can be viewed by [clicking here](#).

Bloomington Golf Club:

Bloomington Golf Club has closed its golf course and cancelled their FISH FRY for the remainder of the period. However, they are offering a limited **Curbside menu**. Their catering department will be offering a BROASTED CHICKEN DINNER on **Wednesdays** and FISH FRY DINNER on **Fridays!** Phone orders will be taken each day beginning at 3:00 PM with credit card payment at the time you place your order. Bloomington Library:

Starting Monday, March 16 the library is closed to patrons through April 5 and could be extended. Please see www.mybpl.org for 24/7 access to resources.

Bloomingtondale Township:

With public health concerns, Bloomingtondale Township services are open by appointment at this time. They have restricted in-person visits, and ask that you please call to make an appointment before coming for Passports, Disabled Parking Placards, Food Pantry, General Assistance, Emergency Assistance, or the Youth Service Bureau. If you need assistance, please call 630.529.7715. The Food Pantry will be offering drive up pickup to minimize personal contact.

As a precautionary measure, the Township Senior Center has canceled all activities, including income tax appointments. The building will be closed until March 30th. MEALS ON WHEELS will still be operating. Staff will still be on site to answer phone calls and make appointments for essential services. Bloomingtondale Park District:

The Bloomingtondale Park District is CLOSED and all programs are SUSPENDED until April 5. The following facilities will be closed to the public. Johnston Recreation Center, Westfield Gymnasium, - Museum, and Maintenance Building. Park Board meetings will continue. Schedule and agendas. Despite the building being open for this short period of time, there is NO in-person registration and ALL public places within the JRC (Clubhouse, B-Fit Center, The Lounge, etc.) remain CLOSED. During the closure, there is NO in-person registration. Limited registration desk staff will be present the following days and times to answer questions and concerns over the phone (NOT in person). Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Saturday-Sunday, CLOSED

Other Events:

The Village has been notified of the following community event cancellations:
