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PROHIBITING STREET PARKING ON CERTAIN AREAS OF THIRD STREET,  
WASHINGTON STREET, AND DAY STREET WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF  
BLOOMINGDALE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois is a home rule unit of local government, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, except as limited by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution;

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that a Home Rule Unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of those ordinances of the Village which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Bloomingdale, as amended;

**WHEREAS**, the Old Town Preservation District located within the Village has seen rapid growth and redevelopment resulting in a higher demand for parking;

**WHEREAS**, the streets located within the Old Town Preservation District are substandard in width and currently allow street parking on both sides;

**WHEREAS**, Title 7 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic) Chapter 2 (Parking Regulations) Section 3 (Parking Prohibited in Specific Places) generally provides that no person shall park at any place where official signs prohibit parking;

**WHEREAS**, the increased demand for parking and narrow streets could make it difficult for emergency vehicles to gain proper access throughout the area and respond to residents in a timely manner;

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities recognize that consistent economic growth, although positive for the community as a whole, can sometimes cause disruptions and inconveniences to residential areas including but not limited to congesting neighborhood streets and related safety and security risks;

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bloomingdale are of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Village of Bloomingdale to prohibit parking on certain streets within the Village in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Village of Bloomingdale Code of Ordinances as provided for herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois pursuant to the Village of Bloomingdale's "Home Rule Powers" as follows:

**Section One – Recitals**

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section Two – Authorization to Erect Signs**

The Corporate Authorities hereby prohibit and/or restrict parking, and authorize Village Staff to erect appropriate signage indicating such, on the following streets:

1. Prohibit parking on both sides of Third Street from Bloomingdale Road to the Village parking lot;
2. Prohibit parking on the south side of Washington Street from Bloomingdale Road to Third Street;
3. Restrict parking to permitted vehicles only on the north side of Washington Street from Bloomingdale Road to Third Street; and
4. On the fire hydrant side of Day Street from Third Street to the dead end.

**Section Three –Other Actions Authorized**

The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this ordinance and otherwise to take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including but not limited to erecting appropriate signage to prohibit parking on certain streets as provided herein, and enforcing the relevant provisions of the Village Code for those individuals who do not abide by such regulations.

**Section Four – Home Rule Preemption**

This ordinance represents an exercise of the home rule powers conferred upon the Village of Bloomingdale by the Constitution of the State of Illinois. This ordinance is specifically intended to preempt state law pertaining to the extent permitted under the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

**Section Five – Effective Date:**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**Section Six - Publication**

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section Seven - Conflict Clause**

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms of this ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

**Section Eight – Saving Clause**

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the Village’s Municipal Code, which are hereby declared to be separable.

**Section Nine - Recording**

This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale.
