ORDINANCE NO. 2023-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 9 (WATER AND SEWER); CHAPTER 1 (GENERAL WATER AND SEWER REGULATIONS; RATES AND CHARGES), SECTION 6 A. 1. (RATES AND CHARGES)

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, except as limited by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the Village provide for the regulation, operation, maintenance, and capital improvement of the Village owned and operated waterworks and sewerage system (the “System”), and establish rates and charges for water and sewer services provided by said System; and

WHEREAS, the Village is a charter member and contract customer of the Du Page Water Commission (the “Water Commission”) and is required to purchase all of its potable water from the Water Commission as defined in the agreement between the Village and the Water Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Water Commission has recently been informed of price increases from the City of Chicago for the purchase of potable water by the Water Commission; and

WHEREAS, due to the financial needs of the Water Commission in assuring an uninterrupted supply of Lake Michigan Water to its charter customers and contract customers, the Water Commission has increased, and is expected to continue to increase, the cost to the Village for the purchase of potable water; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees (hereinafter referred to as the “Village Board”) reviews the revenues and expenses estimated to be necessary for the operation, maintenance, and capital improvement of the System; and

WHEREAS, the Village Finance Director/Treasurer recently recommended changes to certain water and/or sewer related rates and charges that will improve the financial position of the Waterworks And Sewerage Fund and allow for the operation, maintenance, and capital improvement of the System; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that the recommendations of the Village Finance Director/Treasurer concerning changes to certain water and/or sewer rates and charges are reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board further finds that there is no other source of revenue available to the System to improve the financial position of the Water And Sewer Fund and allow for the operation, maintenance, and capital improvement of the System other than to increase the rates and charges assessed to the customers of the System by amending the previously established structure of the rates and charges for water and sewer services provided by said System; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting has been held to explain and receive input from the public relative to the rates and charges of the System; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance represents an exercise of the home rule powers conferred upon the Village by the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section One: The foregoing recitals shall be, and are hereby, incorporated into and made a part of this Ordinance as the findings of the Village Board.

Section Two: Title 9 (Water And Sewer); Chapter 1 (General Water And Sewer Regulations; Rates And Charges); Section 6 A. 1. (Rates And Charges) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

a. Effective for water use on or after June 1, 2023, the following charges are established for water and sewerage service:

<u>RESIDENTIAL -</u>		
• First 2,500 gallons per month or any portion thereof (minimum bill)	\$21.53	\$11.33
• Next 9,500 gallons per month (per 1,000 gallons)	\$8.61	\$4.53
• All over 12,000 gallons per month (per 1,000 gallons)	\$8.61	\$0.00
<u>NON-RESIDENTIAL -</u>		
• First 2,500 gallons per month or any portion thereof (minimum bill)	\$23.93	\$11.33
• All over 2,500 gallons per month (per 1,000 gallons)	\$9.57	\$4.53

Section Three: That a copy of this ordinance, properly certified by the Village Clerk, shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of Du Page County, Illinois and shall be deemed notice to all owners of real estate of their liability for water and sewer service supplied to any occupant or user of the System.

Section Four: The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable such that, in the event of any finding of invalidity as to any provision(s) of this Ordinance, any such invalid provision(s) of this Ordinance shall be severed here from without rendering invalid the balance of this Ordinance.

Section Five: Any and all policies, resolutions or ordinances of the Village that conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be, and they are hereby, repealed.

Section Six: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
