**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE,  
AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS);  
CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES)  
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS P-4 (ON PREMISE CONSUMPTION),  
CAPUTO'S NEW FARM PRODUCE BLOOMINGDALE, INC.  
(D.B.A. CAPUTO'S FRESH MARKET)**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, Caputo's New Farm Produce Bloomingdale, Inc. has applied for a Class P-4 (On Premise Consumption) and Class V (Video Gaming) Village liquor license, to sell and serve alcoholic beverages and to operate video gaming within the dining area of their remodeled Caputo's Fresh Market grocery store, located at 166 E. Lake Street, Bloomingdale.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to increase the number of Class P-4 (On Premise) liquor licenses by one (1), resulting in a final count of two (2) Class P-4, and after the adjustment for expired liquor licenses not renewed for 2022, summarized in table below. (Per Village Ordinance 2018-27, "If any such license described herein is revoked, surrendered, or abandoned that class of license shall automatically be reduced by one.)
