ORDINANCE NO. 2022-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “V” LIQUOR LICENSES, AND TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “D-2” LIQUOR LICENSES, (MANDARIN BISTRO, INC.), AND INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “D-2” LIQUOR LICENSES (INNOVATOR Z, LLC), D.B.A. (MANDARIN BISTRO), 156B E. LAKE ST.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, **Mandarin Bistro, Inc.** was the previous owner, and **INNOVATOR Z, LLC** is the new owner and operator of the Mandarin Bistro, 156B E. Lake Street.

WHEREAS, **INNOVATOR Z, LLC** removed the video gaming terminals and does not plan to pursue Video Gaming at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to decrease the number of Class V (Video Gaming) liquor licenses by one (1), resulting in the maintenance of seven (7) Class V (Video Gaming) liquor licenses, and to decrease the number of Class D-2 liquor licenses by one (1), followed by an increase to the number of Class D-2 liquor license by one (1), resulting in the maintenance of twenty (20) total Class D-2 liquor licenses.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
