**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE,
AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS);
CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES)
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS "D-2" LIQUOR LICENSES
(FIRST WATCH RESTAURANTS, INC.), D.B.A. (FIRST WATCH #0677),
302 W ARMY TRAIL RD.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, **First Watch Restaurants, Inc.** is the owner and operator of First Watch #0677, 302 W. Army Trail Road; and

WHEREAS, **First Watch Restaurants, Inc.** desires to serve signature cocktails consisting of hard liquor for consumption with their breakfast and brunch menu.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to increase to the number of Class D-2 liquor license by one (1), resulting in the maintenance of twenty-one (21) total Class D-2 liquor licenses.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
