ORDINANCE 2022- 37

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 7 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC); CHAPTER 3 (TRAFFIC SCHEDULES); SECTION 2 (STOP INTERSECTIONS) AND SECTION 4 (SPEED LIMITS) TO ESTABLISH OR AMEND TRAFFIC CONTROL ON CERTAIN VILLAGE STREETS

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

WHEREAS, except as limited by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-304, the Village Board may establish that certain intersection streets under the Village’s jurisdiction should be controlled by the establishment of stop controls; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-304, the Village Board may establish certain speed limits in accordance with State of Illinois Statutes for streets under the Village’s jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineer has undertaken engineering traffic investigation pursuant to the applicable standards published in the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (herein the “MUTCD”), and has presented the findings to the Village Board; and

WHEREAS, the Village Engineering and Police Departments have conducted analysis of conditions at various locations necessitating that the Village post signage; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance represents an exercise of the home rule powers conferred upon the Village of Bloomingdale by the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois pursuant to its home rule powers as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two - Adoption of Findings and Recommendations

That Title 7 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 3 (Traffic Schedules); Section 2 (Stop intersections) of the Village Code of Bloomingdale is hereby amended to amend and establish Yield control at the following intersections:

7-3-2 STOP INTERSECTIONS:

The following street intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections in the manner hereinafter provided, and all vehicular traffic shall stop before entering or crossing the intersection so designated:

Street	Direction of Travel	Intersection with
Donald Drive	Westbound	Knollwood Drive
Donald Drive	Northbound	Jorrie Lane
Donmor Drive	Eastbound	Springfield Drive
Jorrie Lane	Northbound	Mall Ring Road
Stonington Drive	Westbound	Knollwood Drive

7-3-4 SPEED LIMITS:

The following streets are hereby designated as to be posted with a 25 mile per hour maximum speed limit requiring all vehicular traffic to comply with the designated posted speed limit:

Street
Donald Drive
Donmor Drive
Jorrie Lane
Stonington Drive

Section Three – Conflicting Provisions

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section Four – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Section Five - Recording


This Ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees.
