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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
TITLE 1 CHAPTER 8 SECTION 1-8-3 OF
THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE
CODE OF ORDINANCES
(COMPENSATION FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale (hereinafter referred to as "Village") is a Home Rule unit of local government with authority granted pursuant to the Illinois Constitution of 1970, to exercise certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that the Village President and Board of Trustees (collectively, the "Corporate Authorities") of a Home Rule Unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt;

WHEREAS, the Village has in full force and effect a codified set of those ordinances of the Village which are of a general and permanent nature, which said codified set is known and designated as the Village Code of the Village of Bloomingdale, as amended;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code (hereinafter referred to as the "Municipal Code") the Village is authorized to establish and fix the compensation of the corporate authorities;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the compensation of the corporate authorities must be fixed at least 180 days before the beginning of the term of the officers whose compensations is to be fixed;

WHEREAS, Title 1 (Administration) Chapter 8 (Village Officers and Personnel) Section 1-8-3 provides the compensation structure for Village elected officials;

WHEREAS, Section 1-8-3 of the Village Code is currently structured to compensate elected officials based on the number of monthly meetings are attended;

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village desire to amend the Village Code to restructure method of compensation to a monthly stipend; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bloomingdale are of the opinion that the aforementioned amendment to the Village's Code of Ordinances is in the best interest of the public safety, health and welfare of the residents of the Village of Bloomingdale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, in open meeting assembled, by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois, pursuant to the Village's Home Rule Powers, as follows:

Section One - Recitals

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to the ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this ordinance as legislative findings.

Section Two – Amendment to Section 1-8-3

Title 1 (Administration) Chapter 8 (Village Officers and Personnel) Section 1-8-3 (Compensation for Elected Officials) shall be amended as follows:

A. Village Trustees:

1. Each Village Trustee shall receive the following compensation:

Effective Date	Compensation
May 1, 2007	\$90.00 for each Board of Trustees or Committee of the Whole meeting attended, with a maximum of \$360.00 per month
May 1, 2025	\$500.00 per month

2. All Village Trustees who are elected in the April 2007 Municipal election to fill a four (4) year term of office and all Trustees elected or appointed thereafter shall receive compensation of ninety dollars (\$90.00) for each and every official special meeting attended, with a maximum of twelve (12) such official special meetings per fiscal year as compensation for attendance at such official special meetings by the Trustee. Such special meetings are duly called and posted as standing committee of the whole or Village Board meetings, and are called in addition to those meetings published on a yearly basis as required by law. A continued regular meeting shall not constitute a special meeting.

B. Village President:

1. The Village President shall receive the following compensation:

Effective Date	Compensation
May 1, 2009	\$900.00 per month, plus \$100.00 per month as Liquor Control Commissioner
May 1, 2025	\$1,225.00 per month

C. Village Clerk:

1. The Village Clerk shall receive the following compensation:

Effective Date	Compensation
May 1, 2017	\$200.00 for each Board of Trustees or Committee of the Whole meeting attended, with a maximum of \$600.00 per month.
May 1, 2025	\$975.00 per month.

- D. **Compensation Increases:** On May 1 of every year, the compensation of the Village President/Liquor Control Commissioner, the Village Clerk and the Village Trustees shall be increased by the lesser of three percent (3%) or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for the twelve (12) month period preceding May 1. The term "Consumer Price Index" shall mean the Chicago area Consumer Price Index for all urban consumers for all items as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor or any successor index created by the Department of Labor as a substitute index that measures the average change in prices of goods and services purchased by urban consumers. The most recent consumer price index available on May 1 of each year shall be used in applying this subsection to any increases in compensation. If the index is a negative number, then there shall be no decrease in the compensation, but the compensation shall remain the same as the previous fiscal year. Amounts for monthly and per meeting compensation shall be rounded to the nearest whole dollar.
- E. **Payment Of Compensation:** Compensation shall be paid in the form of a monthly stipend check, in accordance with the Village's usual and customary payroll practices.

Section Three – Codification

The title, chapter(s) and section(s) adopted by this ordinance shall be numbered and placed in an appropriate title, chapter(s), and sections(s) sections when and during the codification of the Bloomingdale Municipal Code.

Section Four – Home Rule Preemption

This ordinance represents an exercise of the home rule powers conferred upon the Village of Bloomingdale by the Constitution of the State of Illinois. This ordinance is specifically intended to preempt state law pertaining to the extent permitted under the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

Section Five – Effective Date:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section Six - Publication

This ordinance shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section Seven - Conflict Clause

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the terms of this Ordinance shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section Eight– Saving Clause

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the Village's Municipal Code, which are hereby declared to be separable.

Section Nine - Recording


This ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale.


