**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO PERMIT CLASS P-4 LICENSES TO APPLY FOR CLASS V (VIDEO GAMING) LICENSES**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Video Gaming Act enacted in 2009 allowed the use of video gaming terminals in licensed establishments. A licensed establishment under the Act includes retail establishments where alcoholic liquor is served for consumption on the premises; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale passed Ordinance 2014-12 to amend the Code of the Village to permit video gaming in establishments with a Class D - Dining, Class H - Hotel or Class R - Resort Liquor license that have been issued a Class V (Supplemental Video Gaming Liquor License).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to permit Class P-4 (On Premise) to apply and receive a Class V (Video Gaming) liquor licenses based on compliance with rules and regulations set forth by the Village of Bloomigdale for such license.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
