**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-09**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “P-3” LIQUOR LICENSES, (SURREY ENTERPRISES INC.), AND INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “P-3” LIQUOR LICENSES (VISHMA CORPORATION), D.B.A. (HOME TOWN PANTRY), 360 W SCHICK ROAD, STE 24.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS, SURREY ENTERPRISES INC.** was the previous owner of the Home Town Pantry at 360 W. Schick Road, Suite 24, and **VISHMA CORPORATION** is the new owner and operator of the Home Town Pantry, at 360 W. Schick Road, Suite 24.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to decrease the number of Class P-3 liquor licenses by one (1), followed by an increase to the number of Class P-3 liquor license by one, resulting in the maintenance of one (1) total Class P-3 liquor licenses.

**SECTION 2:** Per Village Ordinance 2018-27, “If any such license described herein is revoked, surrendered, or abandoned that class of license shall automatically be reduced by one.” A summary of the licenses that did not renew for 2021 and are now expired are summarized in the table below:
