**ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 17**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISPOSAL  
OF SURPLUS PROPERTY  
OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, except as limited by such Section 6, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Bloomingdale Village Code; Title 3 (Finance & Taxation); Chapter 2 (PURCHASING, PROCUREMENT AND DISPOSAL PROCEDURES); Section 7. (Competitive Bidding, Advertising, And Disposal Procedures And Requirements); Subsection E. (Disposal of Personal Property Under \$20,000) in the opinion of at least a simple majority of the corporate authorities of the Village, it is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of the Village to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Village President and Board of Trustees to trade in, sell, donate or dispose of said personal property through a means defined necessary at the time; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED By The President and Board of Trustees of The Village of Bloomingdale, Du Page County, Illinois, Pursuant To Its Home Rule Powers, As Follows:**

**SECTION ONE:** The Village President and Board of Trustees find that the following described surplus personal property now owned by the Village is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and the best interests of the Village will be served by its sale or disposal.

**SECTION TWO:** Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to trade in, sell, or dispose of the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village through a means deemed necessary at the time.

**SECTION THREE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a simple majority vote of the corporate authorities, and approval in the manner provided by law.
