**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-24**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS "H" LIQUOR LICENSES, (AHTRST CONCESSIONS, LLC), AND INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS "H" LIQUOR LICENSES (HIGHGATE HOTELS L.P), D.B.A. (COURTYARD CHICAGO BLOOMINGDALE), 275 KNOLLWOOD DRIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, AHTRST Concessions, LLC was the previous owner and Highgate Hotels L.P, is the new owner of the Courtyard Chicago Bloomingdale, 275 Knollwood Drive.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to decrease the number of Class H liquor licenses by one (1), followed by an increase to the number of Class H liquor license by one, resulting in the maintenance of one (1) total Class H liquor licenses.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
