ORDINANCE NO. 2021-30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS); CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES) TO DECREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “P-2” LIQUOR LICENSES, (JAY PURSHOTTAM CORP), AND INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS “P-2” LIQUOR LICENSES (DIYA A910, INC), D.B.A. (PIK N GO LIQUORS), 276 GLEN ELLYN ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, **JAY PURSHOTTAM CORP** was the previous owner, and **DIYA A910, INC** is the new owner and operator of the Pik N Go Liquors, 276 Glen Ellyn Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:

SECTION 1: Title 4 (Business and License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to decrease the number of Class P-2 liquor licenses by one (1), followed by an increase to the number of Class P-2 liquor license by one (1), resulting in the maintenance of three (3) total Class P-2 liquor licenses.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
