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**ORDINANCE 2021- 42**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, AS AMENDED, TITLE 7 (MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC); CHAPTER 3 (TRAFFIC SCHEDULES); SECTION 2 (STOP INTERSECTIONS) AND SECTION 3 (YIELD INTERSECTIONS) TO ESTABLISH OR AMEND TRAFFIC CONTROL ON SPRING VALLEY DRIVE, WHITE HALL TERRACE AND OLD MILL LANE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, except as limited by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax and to incur debt; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-304, the Village Board may establish that certain intersection streets under the Village’s jurisdiction should be controlled by the establishment of either two-way or all-way stop controls; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-304, the Village Board may establish that certain intersection streets under the Village’s jurisdiction should be controlled by the establishment of yield controls; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Engineer has undertaken engineering traffic investigation pursuant to the applicable standards published in the 2009 Edition of the Manual on Uniform

Traffic Control Devices (herein the “MUTCD”), and has presented the findings to the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance represents an exercise of the home rule powers conferred upon the Village of Bloomingdale by the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, in open meeting assembled by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois pursuant to its home rule powers as follows:

**Section One - Recitals**

The Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Ordinance as legislative findings.

**Section Two - Adoption of Findings and Recommendations**

That Title 7 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 3 (Traffic Schedules); Section 2 (Stop Intersections) of the Village Code of Bloomingdale is hereby amended to establish Stop control at the following intersection:

**7-3-2 STOP INTERSECTIONS:**

The following street intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections in the manner hereinafter provided, and all vehicular traffic shall stop before entering or crossing the intersection so designated:

Street	Direction of Travel	Intersection with
Spring Valley Drive	Westbound	North Circle Avenue
Old Mill Lane	Westbound	Butterfield Drive
White Hall Terrace	Westbound	Butterfield Drive

That Title 7 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 3 (Traffic Schedules); Section 3 (Yield intersections) of the Village Code of Bloomingdale is hereby amended to remove yield control at the following intersection:

7-3-3 YIELD INTERSECTIONS:

The following street intersections currently designated as yield intersections in the manner hereinafter provided, shall be removed from this schedule:

Street	Direction of Travel	Intersection with
Spring Valley Drive	Westbound	North Circle Avenue

That Title 7 (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 3 (Traffic Schedules); Section 3 (Yield intersections) of the Village Code of Bloomingdale is hereby amended to amend and establish Yield control at the following intersections:

7-3-3 YIELD INTERSECTIONS:

The following street intersections are hereby designated as yield intersections in the manner hereinafter provided, and all vehicular traffic shall yield before entering or crossing the intersection so designated:

Street	Direction of Travel	Intersection with
Spring Valley Drive	Eastbound	N Prairie Avenue
Spring Valley Drive	Westbound	N Prairie Avenue
Spring Valley Drive	Eastbound	N Pleasant Avenue

**Section Three – Conflicting Provisions**

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section Four – Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

**Section Five - Recording**

This Ordinance shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees.
