**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-35**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BLOOMINGDALE VILLAGE CODE,  
AS AMENDED, TITLE 4 (BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS);  
CHAPTER 2 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES); SECTION 10 (NUMBER OF LICENSES)  
TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS "D-2" LIQUOR LICENSES,  
OKAPI GROUP LLC (D.B.A. OKAPI BISTRO)**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, OKAPI Group LLC has submitted an application for a Class D-2 Dining (Full Liquor) Village liquor license, to sell alcoholic beverages at their new OKAPI Bistro restaurant located at 369 W. Army Trail Rd., Suite 11, Bloomingdale.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, IN THE EXERCISE OF ITS HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**


**SECTION 1:** Title 4 (Business And License Regulations); Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages); Section 10 (Number of Licenses) of the Bloomingdale Village Code is hereby amended, as set forth on the attached Exhibit A, to increase the number of Class D-2 liquor licenses by one (1), resulting in a final count of twenty two (22) total Class D-2 liquor licenses.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
