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**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-18**

**A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE  
COMMISSION TO AMEND ITS LATERAL TRANSFER POLICY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale (hereinafter referred to as "Village") is a home rule unit of local government with authority granted pursuant to the Illinois Constitution of 1970, to exercise certain powers and perform certain functions pertaining to its local government and affairs;

**WHEREAS**, the Illinois Constitution of 1970 provides that a Home Rule Unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has appointed a duly authorized Board of Fire and Police Commissioners (hereinafter the "Commission") pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-1 and to carry out the purposes provided therein on behalf of the Village;

**WHEREAS**, the Village has authorized the Commission to create a set of Rules to effectively carry out its purposes and for appointments and removals pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-5;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission has previously adopted a lateral transfer policy to encourage new applicants for the Police Department as provided by State Statute;

**WHEREAS**, 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6 (h) provides in relevant part: "A board of fire and police commissioners may, by its rules, waive portions of the required examination for police applicants who have previously been full-time sworn officers of a regular police department in any municipal, county, university, or State law enforcement agency, provided they are certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board and have been with their respective law enforcement agency within the State for at least 2 years.";

**WHEREAS**, 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-14 provides in relevant part: "The board of fire and police commissioners may prepare and keep a second register of persons who have previously been full-time sworn officers of a regular police department in any municipal, county, university, or State law enforcement agency, provided they are certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board and have been with their respective law enforcement agency within the State for at least 2 years.";

**WHEREAS**, the Commission desires to amend its existing lateral transfer policy to only require full-time applicants to have been with their respective law enforcement agency within the State for at least 1 year;

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bloomingdale are of the opinion that that it is in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the residents of the Village to authorize the Commission, pursuant to its home rule authorities, to adopt the employment policy as referenced herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, in open meeting assembled by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois pursuant to its home rule powers as follows:

**Section One – Recitals**

The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this Resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

**Section Two – Authorization and Ratification**

The Board hereby authorizes the Commission to invoke the Village's home rule powers to adopt a Lateral Transfer Policy substantially in the form attached hereto and incorporated herein as EXHIBIT A. The Board further authorizes any other necessary action and ratifies any actions

already taken by the Commission in the furtherance of the adoption of the policy provided for by this Resolution.

**Section Three – Home Rule Preemption**

This resolution represents the Village of Bloomingdale’s exercise of its home rule powers to the extent that this ordinance preempts or conflicts with Illinois statute to the extent permitted under the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

**Section Four - Effective Date:**

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**Section Five - Publication**

This resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section Six - Conflict Clause**

That all resolutions, parts of resolutions or board actions in conflict with the terms of this resolution shall be repealed to the extent of said conflict.

**Section Seven - Recording**

This Resolution shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale.
