FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALS LOCATED ON STATE HIGHWAYS

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WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the State of Illinois, 1970, Article VII, Section 10, authorizes units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 5 ILCS 220/5 of the "Intergovernmental Cooperation Act", any one or more public agencies may contract with any one or more public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which any of the public agencies entering into the contract is authorized by law to perform, provided that such contract shall be authorized by the governing body of each party to the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Village and the Illinois Department of Transportation (“IDOT”) are authorized to regulate the use of the public rights-of-way and streets for the benefit of the public; and

WHEREAS, the Village and IDOT have previously entered into a Local Agency Traffic Control Devices Master Agreement (“Master Agreement”) which is set to expire on June 30, 2021 which defines responsibility to complete all necessary work to maintain and energize all traffic signals and local benefit traffic control devices at certain intersections located on State highways within the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to, and as detailed in the “Master Agreement” IDOT and the Village have agreed to each respective Agency’s responsibility to maintain said devices at certain intersections located on State highways within the Village, and the apportionment of the related costs of providing said maintenance and energy at each location; and

WHEREAS, IDOT proposes to enter into a new the “Master Agreement” with an effective date of July 1, 2021 and an expiration date of June 30, 2031 in order to reflect and comply with the current conditions, jurisdictions and traffic signal agreements of certain affected intersections as indicated in the “Intergovernmental Master Agreement” attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Recitals: The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to the Resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

SECTION 2: Approval Of Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment: The “Intergovernmental Master Agreement” between the Village and IDOT is hereby approved, and the Village President and Village Clerk respectively, are authorized to execute and attest the Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and any finally negotiated terms as set forth therein.

SECTION 3: Other Actions Authorized: The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this Resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

SECTION 4: Acts of Village Officials: That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

SECTION 5: Repeal of Conflicting Resolutions: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6: Effective Date: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
