A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE BLOOMINGDALE TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURCHASE OF A ELGIN BROOM BEAR STREET SWEEPER

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section 6, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale Village conducts the annual street sweeping for all residential streets within the jurisdiction of the Village of Bloomingdale through a contract with Lakeshore Recycling; and

WHEREAS, the Bloomingdale Township owns a street sweeper that has not been used and is currently seeking to sell to the Village of Bloomingdale providing the Village greater flexibility and increasing the number of sweeps by bringing this service under the responsibility of the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Bloomingdale Township has valued the street sweeper at \$220k with the same sweeper new having a list price of \$300k and as such the Village and Township have agreed to a purchase price of \$206,000; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bloomingdale, it is in the best interests of the Village to enter into the Purchase Agreement for the acquisition of the Elgin Broom Bear Street Sweeper from the Bloomingdale Township; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Village President and Village Clerk are each respectively authorized to execute and attest to the Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as required by law.
