

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A FINANCIAL REIMBURSEMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BLOOMINGDALE TOWNSHIP AND THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGDALE FOR 2022 WEEKEND PARATRANSIT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule unit of local government under Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution and, except as limited by such Section, it may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Bloomingdale Township (the “Township”) is a unit of local government established under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Township have the legal authority to enter into an intergovernmental agreement pursuant to Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Village’s Home Rule Authority; and

WHEREAS, for a period of years, the Village has subsidized weekend paratransit services for Village residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Township desire to have the Township renew their intergovernmental agreement with Pace (the Suburban Bus System) to provide weekend services to Village residents for calendar year 2022, under an agreement between Pace and the Township.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section One – Recitals: The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to the Resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

Section Two – Approval of Intergovernmental Agreement: The Village hereby approves the Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A-2, and directs the Village President or his designee to negotiate final terms, if any, with the advice of the Village’s Corporation Counsel.

Section Three – Authorization and Direction: The Village President is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to sign, and the Village Clerk to attest thereto, the agreement presented herein and any finally negotiated terms as set forth therein.

Section Four - Other Actions Authorized: The officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this Resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

Section Five - Acts of Village Officials: That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officials of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

Section Six: All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Section Seven: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as required by law.

**FINANCIAL REIMBURSEMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN BLOOMINGDALE TOWNSHIP AND THE VILLAGE OF
BLOOMINGDALE FOR PARATRANSIT SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Bloomingdale Township is a unit of local government established under the laws of the State of Illinois and is hereinafter referred to as "Township"; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomingdale is an Illinois municipal corporation and is hereinafter referred to as "Village"; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP for a period of years has provided weekday paratransit services through Pace's Dial-A-Ride for the TOWNSHIP residents; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE for a period of years has provided weekend paratransit services also through Pace's Dial-A-Ride for VILLAGE residents; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP on behalf of the Village will enter into an agreement with Pace to provide the weekend services to the VILLAGE residents for 2022 similar to the services as previously provided for under agreement between Pace and the VILLAGE for 2021; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE have determined that the TOWNSHIP's customary subsidy from Pace can be more fully utilized for the benefit of the residents of both the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE have determined that it is reasonable for the VILLAGE to reimburse the TOWNSHIP for the VILLAGE portion of the 2022 weekend services that will now be billed to the TOWNSHIP; and

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE have the legal authority to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement pursuant to Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to establish the TOWNSHIP's and VILLAGE's duties and rights with regard to the intergovernmental cooperation for reimbursement for paratransit services for 2022;


NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Agreement as evidence of the intent of the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE and as representing substantive covenants between them.
2. Subject to the termination provisions described below, the VILLAGE shall pay the TOWNSHIP for the weekend paratransit services for the VILLAGE residents at 50% of the Net Operating Deficit for those services as calculated by Pace and as set forth in Exhibit B as NET OPERATING DEFICIT (VIL.).

3. The VILLAGE shall have the right to terminate its participation in this agreement at any time in the sole discretion of the Corporate Authorities of the VILLAGE. Any and all sums due from the VILLAGE up to the date of termination shall be paid by the VILLAGE to the TOWNSHIP at the percentages and amounts as set forth in Exhibit B. Written notice of the VILLAGE's termination shall be provided by facsimile or email, and regular mail to the Bloomingdale Township Supervisor and to Pace. After receipt of termination, no further payments will be required by the VILLAGE.
4. The essence of the agreement is to better use the TOWNSHIP's subsidy from Pace. The duties, responsibilities, and rights of the VILLAGE are to remain unchanged as to its agent relationship with Pace for the weekend services. The TOWNSHIP services are as set forth in Exhibit A-1 for 2022. The VILLAGE services are as set forth in Exhibit A-2 for 2022.
5. This agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2022, or on any date the TOWNSHIP receives written notice of the VILLAGE's intent to terminate this Agreement.
6. The TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE agree that Pace is the independent contractor with regard to the services of this Agreement for 2022.
7. The TOWNSHIP shall invoice the VILLAGE monthly upon receipt of the service month's Net Operating Deficit as attributable to the VILLAGE. The VILLAGE shall reimburse the TOWNSHIP for amounts due within forty-five (45) days of invoice receipt.
8. This Agreement may not be assigned, transferred, or extended without the mutual written consent of the TOWNSHIP and the VILLAGE.
9. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE and all prior discussions and negotiations associated herewith are merged within. Any amendment or modification of this Agreement shall be by mutual written consent only.
10. In witness whereof the TOWNSHIP and VILLAGE have approved this Intergovernmental Agreement by resolution or ordinance and execute the same in conformance therewith.
