**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A  
CHANGE ORDER DECREASING THE ORIGINALLY APPROVED CONTRACT IN  
AN AMOUNT EXCEEDING TWENTY THOUSAND (\$20,000) FOR A CONTRACT  
ORIGINALLY APPROVED IN AN AMOUNT EXCEEDING ONE HUNDRED  
THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000)**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") is a home rule unit of local government, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, except as limited by Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license, to tax; and to incur debt; and

**WHEREAS**, LRZ, Inc. is the owner and operator of Sporty's Restaurant and Catering, 448 W Army Trail Road; and

**WHEREAS**, LRZ, Inc. desires to serve liquor for consumption in their restaurant and has submitted an application for a Class D-2 (Full Liquor) Liquor License; and

**WHEREAS**, the operations as proposed by LRZ, Inc. are consistent with Title 4 (Business and License Regulations), Chapter 2 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Bloomingdale Village Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has one (1) available D-2 Liquor License;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale, DuPage County, Illinois pursuant to the Village of Bloomingdale's "Home Rule Powers" as follows:

**Section One – Recitals:** That the Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals hereinbefore stated as contained in the preamble to this Resolution are full, true and correct and do hereby, by reference, incorporate and make them part of this Resolution as legislative findings.

**Section Two – Approval:** The Village hereby approves the issuance of a D-2 (Full Liquor) Liquor License to LRZ, Inc.

**Section Three – Other Actions Authorized:** That the officers, employees and/or agents of the Village shall take all actions necessary or reasonably required to carry out and give effect to the intent of this Resolution and otherwise to consummate the transactions contemplated herein, and shall take all actions necessary in conformity therewith including, without limitation, the execution and delivery of all documents required to be delivered in connection with the transaction contemplated herein.

**Section Four – Acts of Village Officials:** That all past, present and future acts and doings of the officers, officials, employees and/or agents of the Village that are in conformity with the purpose and intent of this Resolution are hereby, in all respects, ratified, approved, authorized and confirmed.

**Section Five – Effective Date:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

**Section Six – Publication:** That this Resolution shall be published in book or pamphlet form as provided by the Illinois Municipal Code.

**Section Seven – Conflict Cause:** That all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section Eight – Saving Clause:** That if any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution is declared by a court of law to be invalid or unconstitutional, the invalidity or unconstitutionality thereof shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the Resolution, which are hereby declared to be separable.

**Section Nine – Recording:** That this Resolution shall be entered into the minutes and upon the journals of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bloomingdale.
